The INFOCOMMONS, which is part of the Snell Library and the Information Services Department at Northeastern University, is a popular computing and high performance research facility.

Infocommons maintains two computer labs; Infocommons I and Infocommons II. Both labs are located on the first floor of the Snell Library and provide 24/7 access to computer services, which includes self-service scanners, for faculty, staff and students. Staff is available to provide assistance with scanning and other computing needs.

In addition to serving the information services needs of the student body; the Infocommons also serves as a study area for times when the libraries are closed - especially if you need to do some printing. There is no charge for printing.

There is also a Cybercafé for grabbing a bite or some coffee with booths for laptops and a study area.

Starting the week of September 10<sup>th</sup>, the Law Library will be offering scheduled tours of this facility. The Law Library and will post time slots for these tours.
