

How do I enroll in my professor's LexisNexis Web Course?

1. Go to <http://www.lexisnexis.com/lawschool> (the law school version of Lexis).
2. Log in using your LexisNexis Custom ID and password
3. Click on the grey tab labeled "Web Courses"
4. Click on the "Access Web Courses"
5. Click on the tabs at the top of the page labeled "Courses"
6. On the right side of the page, scroll through the names of the schools
7. Click on "Northeastern University"
8. Locate the name of the course and click on the box next to the name of the course (see below for an example)

How do I access a course in which I have enrolled?

1. Follow steps 1-4 above
2. You will see all of your courses in the "My Courses" on the right hand side of the page under the "Web Courses" tab.
3. Click on the name of the course which will be underlined as a live link and you will access that particular course.
