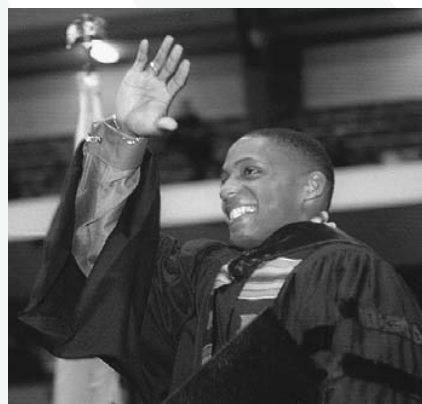
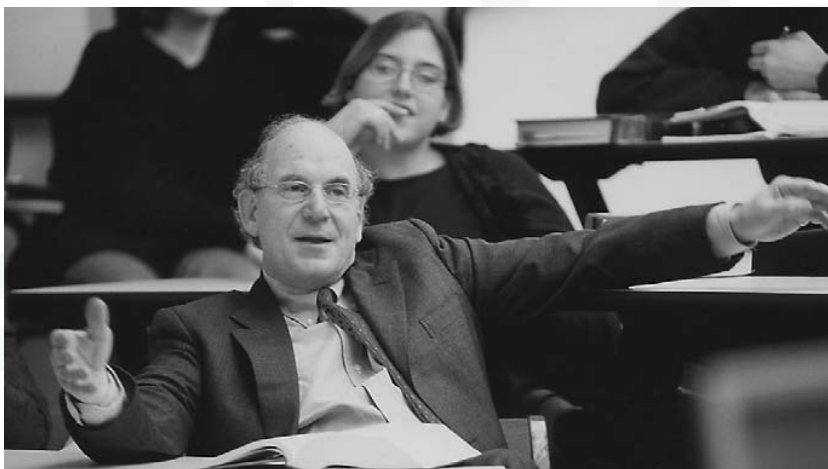

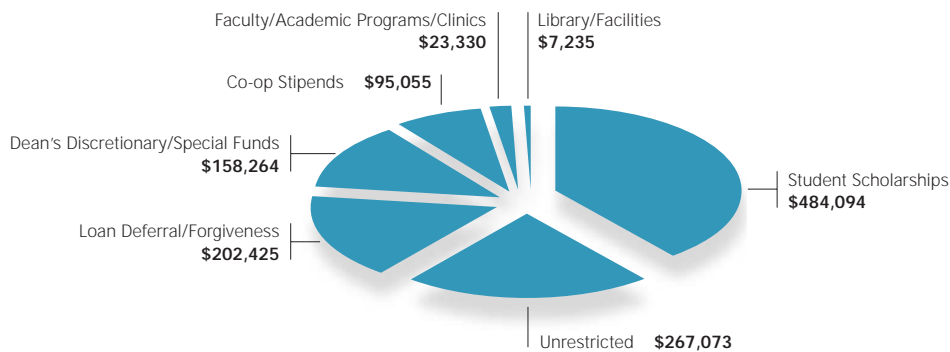

What a difference a year makes! The ups and downs of the stock market over this past fiscal year and the uncertainty of our nation's economic health have many individuals and corporations adjusting their spending and charitable giving. In spite of these realities, and as an affirmation of our mission by our graduates and friends, Northeastern University School of Law enjoyed another successful fundraising year.

Our generous supporters have enabled us to reach a sixth consecutive year of contributions in excess of \$1 million. As the "New Gifts and Pledges by Gift Purpose" chart reveals, the School of Law received \$1,237,476 in new gifts and multi-year pledge commitments during fiscal year 2001. These gifts enhance the current operating budget of the law school and provide permanent support for the future of our programs. We thank all of our donors for your demonstrated confidence in the law school, our mission and the hundreds of students who come here each year.

Special Recognition and Major Gifts

As we salute the generosity of all our supporters, we want to acknowledge particularly those individuals who made substantial outright gifts, multi-year commitments or deferred gifts during this past fiscal year. These extraordinarily generous major gifts allow the School of Law to immediately address its most significant needs and to plan for future enhancements.

Daniel E. Clifton '77 made a leadership gift that we hope will serve as inspiration to other graduates. Mr. Clifton will use half of his \$100,000 multi-year commitment to establish the Morris and Harriet Clifton Public Interest Law Scholarship, a permanently endowed fund supporting the Public Interest Law Scholars Program (PILS). This program offers renewable 75 percent tuition scholarships for six students each year. In response to the desire of Northeastern students to serve the public, and in recognition of the high debt costs associated with attending law school, the Scholars Program seeks to provide significant assistance to selected students who are

committed to public interest law. Dean Abrams will designate the remaining half of Mr. Clifton's commitment for the PILS Program's current use needs.

Mr. Clifton's total commitment is one of a dozen gifts from individuals who increased their support to the major gift level, thus joining the School of Law's Committee of 100. Now in its second year, the Committee of 100 boasts 14 members, each of whom made commitments of at least \$25,000. With the donors' approval, Dean Abrams has already designated many of these commitments for new and ongoing programs.

Committee of 100

In the spring of 2000, Dean Roger Abrams established the Committee of 100 to recognize and inspire those graduates and friends who provide the School of Law with unrestricted leadership support. These donors have made unrestricted gift commitments of at least \$25,000 that the dean may designate for a specific purpose with their approval. 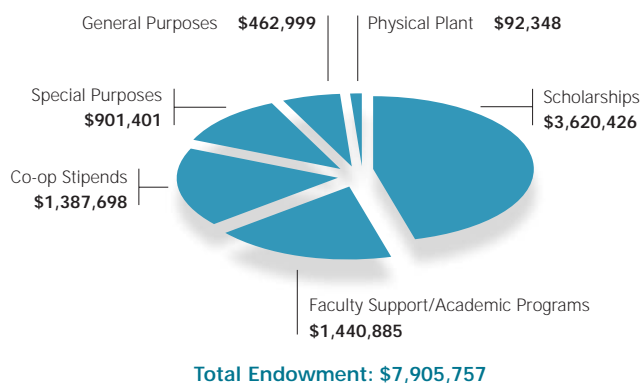
Endowed and Special Funds

The School of Law's total endowment typically increases each year through appreciation and new endowed gifts, and provides needed revenue for our operating expenses and special purposes. Over this past fiscal year, the downturn in financial markets and in the valuation of investment portfolios caused the value of the vast majority of our individually endowed funds to drop significantly. Notwithstanding, new gifts to various endowed funds enabled us to increase the overall value of our endowment by \$284,884 during FY'01. As of June 30, 2001, the School of Law's total endowment had a market value of nearly \$7,905,757, which is designated among five general support areas, as the "Market Value by Endowment Purpose" chart below illustrates. This figure includes all endowed funds held by the university that are permanently restricted for use by the law school. Additionally, the market values of funds held and managed externally by financial fiduciaries that are irrevocably designated for the School of Law's benefit are also included in this figure.

The School of Law's endowment provided approximately \$263,107 in expendable income during fiscal year 2001 to support the general operation of the law school as well as specific scholarships and programs. Of the approximately 61 endowed funds supporting our programs and operating budget, the bulk of these support student scholarships. Gifts that establish endowed funds at the School of Law provide for the long-term financial stability of our institution. Endowed funds may be established to support scholarships, co-op stipends, the library or any of our program areas. With a minimum gift commitment of \$50,000, which may be paid over a period of five years, an endowed fund may be created and named in honor of the donor or as s/he directs. Alternatively, gifts of any size may be made to existing endowed funds.
