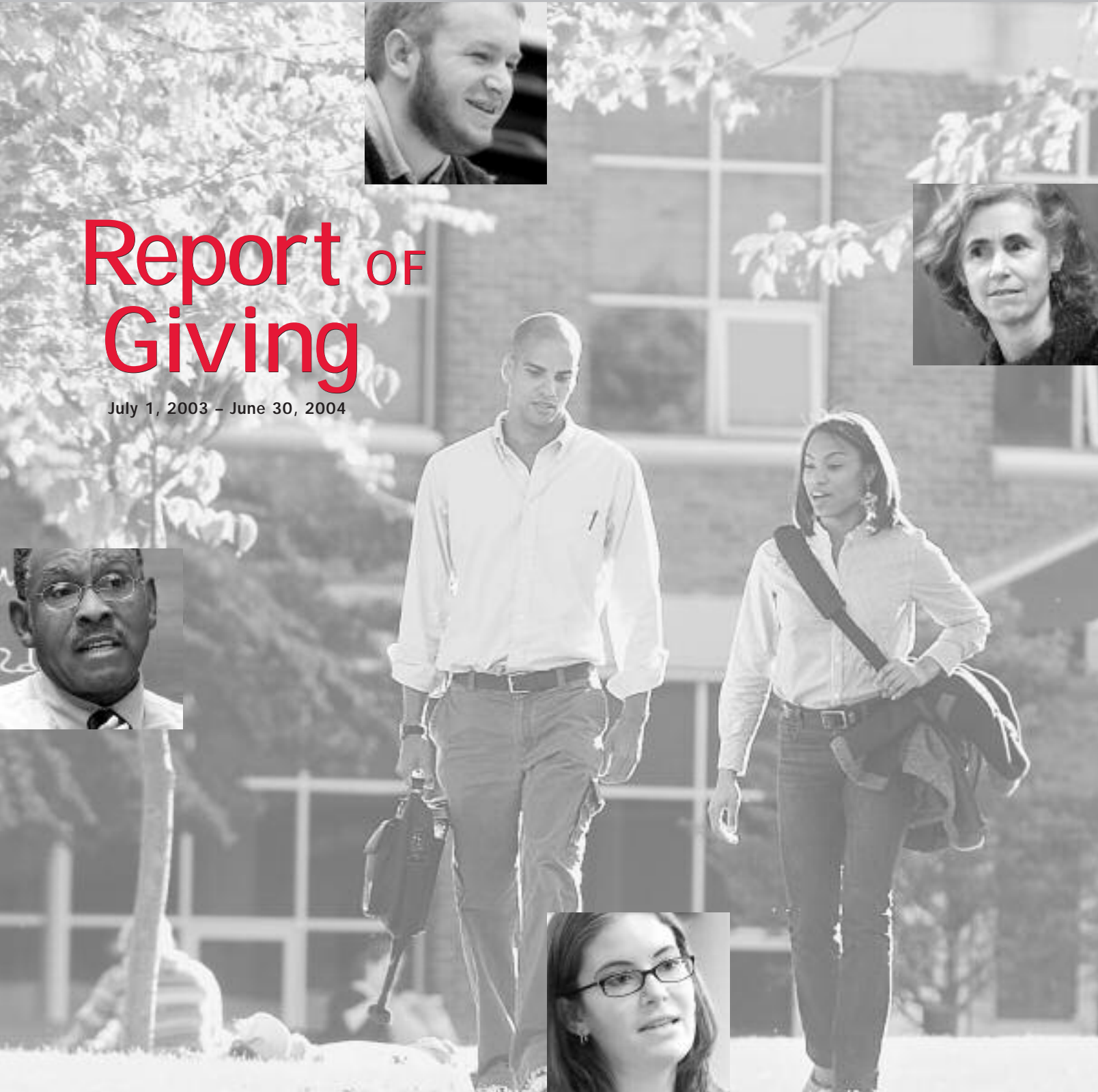

As Northeastern University's **Leadership Campaign: New Pathways to Excellence** enters its final stages, the School of Law is proud to report that we are well on our way toward meeting our campaign goal of \$7.5 million. At the close of fiscal year 2004, the law school had raised \$6,990,297.

We owe our success to you, our loyal graduates and friends, who support us financially each year and in innumerable other ways. Our current campaign, which had its optimistic formulation in the financially booming years of the late 1990s, has progressed toward goal with remarkable steadiness. What a testament this is to you, our donors, and your faith in this institution.

As we end this campaign and begin to think about our next financial goals, the School of Law will continue to reach out to graduates and friends for significant gift commitments that will help enhance our financial assistance capabilities, academic programs, faculty endeavors and physical plant. In addition, we hope to increase awareness of the law school's need for annual unrestricted support. Such gifts to the Annual Fund are the measure of "flexibility" most institutions rely upon to budget for current and unexpected needs that cannot be addressed through other means. The dean's ability to respond to immediate needs is directly tied to the level of unrestricted support we receive annually.

Special Recognition and Major Gifts

As we salute the generosity of all supporters, the School of Law especially acknowledges those individuals who made substantial outright gifts, multiyear commitments or deferred gifts during this past fiscal year. Their extraordinary generosity allows the School of Law to immediately address its most significant needs and to plan for future enhancements.

● Continuing a family tradition spanning more than three generations, Susan and Larry Deitch established the **Susan and Larry Deitch Public Interest Law Scholars Fund** with a gift of \$1.5 million to the School of Law. The Deitch Fund provides three-quarter

scholarships to one student in each class who intends to work in the public interest. The Deitches' gift continues Susan's family legacy of generosity to the law school. In 1975, her grandmother, Ethel Gryzmish, together with her daughters and sons-in-law, Edna and Harry Shpiner and Ruby and Ben Schulman, established a memorial fund in honor of their late husband and father, Reuben B. Gryzmish '12, Hon. '69, to provide scholarships and co-op stipends for students pursuing public interest law. Shortly after, the Schulmans established a second such fund. Today, the funds are valued at more than \$800,000 and generate an impressive \$50,000 in annual income.

● **The Public Interest Law Scholars Program** also benefited from outstanding leadership pledges made by Nonnie S. Burnes '77-'78, the Hiatt family and the Stride Rite Charitable Foundation. Nonnie Burnes, and her husband, Richard, pledged \$147,345 to the **Burnes Scholarship for Public Interest Law**. The Stride Rite Charitable Foundation, under Arnold Hiatt's direction, pledged \$147,345 to the **Stride Rite Scholarship Program**. The Burnes and Hiatt families are among the law school's most generous supporters, with significant gifts to a range of initiatives that support the law school's public interest aspirations.

Committee of 100

In 2000, the Committee of 100 was created to recognize and inspire those graduates and friends who provide the School of Law with leadership-level support. These donors have made primarily unrestricted gift commitments of at least \$25,000, many of which have been designated by the dean for specific purposes. 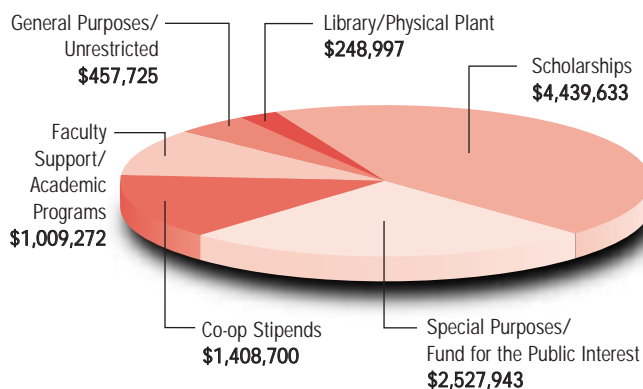
Endowed and Special Funds

The School of Law's total endowment typically increases (and in a bear market can decrease) each year through appreciation and new gifts to its many endowed funds and provides needed revenue for our operating expenses and special purposes. In fiscal year 2004, the overall value of our endowment increased by \$1,186,796. As of June 30, 2004, the School of Law's total endowment reached a market value of \$10,092,270, which is designated among six general support areas, as the "Market Value by Endowment Purpose" chart illustrates. This figure includes all endowed funds and monetary assets held by the university that are permanently restricted for use by the law school. Additionally, the market values of funds held and managed externally by financial fiduciaries that are irrevocably designated for the School of Law's benefit are also included in this figure.

The School of Law's endowment generated approximately \$406,452 in expendable income during fiscal year 2004 to support the general operation of the law school as well as specific scholarships and programs. Of the 63 endowed funds supporting our programs and operating budget, the majority support student scholarships.

Endowed funds may be established with a minimum gift commitment of \$50,000, which may be paid over five years. Endowed funds are named as the donor directs and may support scholarships, co-op stipends, the library or any program area. Gifts of any size may be made to existing endowed funds.

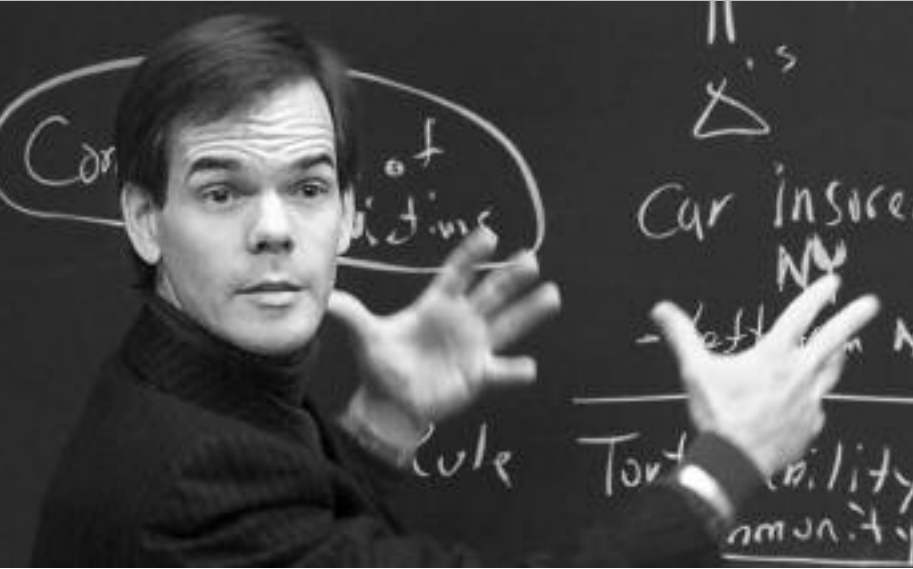
